A special highlight: the double-shell structure makes it possible to choose the interior and exterior carcasses in different colours resulting in original wood and lacquer combinations.

The double-shell carcass design in different colours offers plenty of scope for creativity.

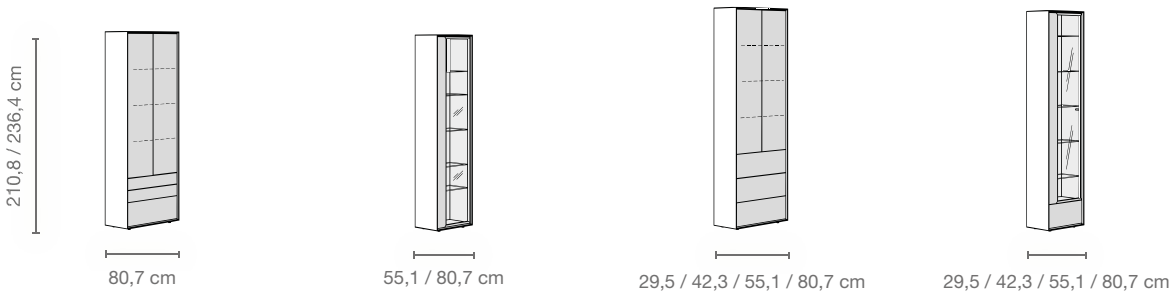

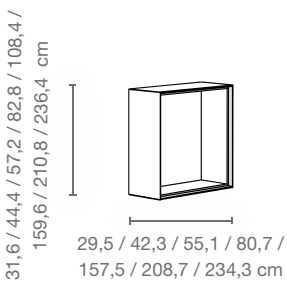

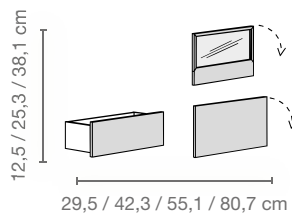

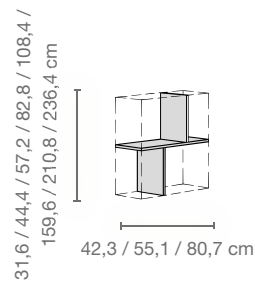

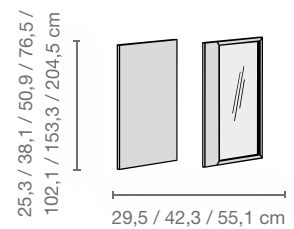

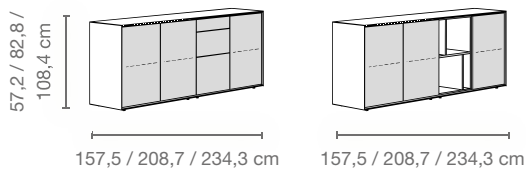

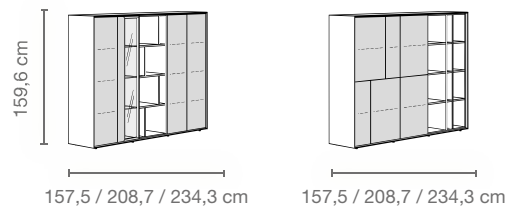

on 2.1 cm high plinth adjusters or as wall unit (6 and 8R sideboards cannot be fitted as wall unit), depth: 46,2 cm



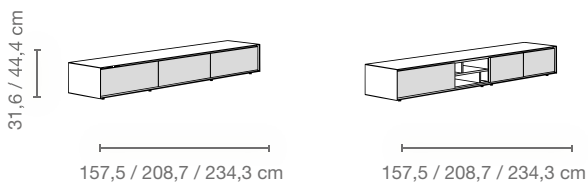
12 raster high highboards

on 2.1 cm high plinth adjusters, depth: 46,2 cm



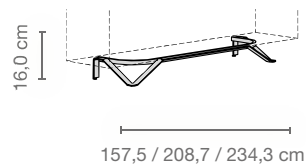
2 / 3 raster high lowboards

with rounded end at both sides, depth: 46,2 cm



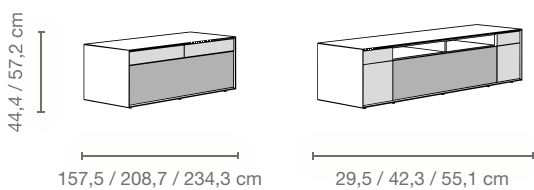
Metal substructures for low-, side- and highboards

Substructure optionally powder-coated graphite or high-gloss chrome, depth: 64,3 cm



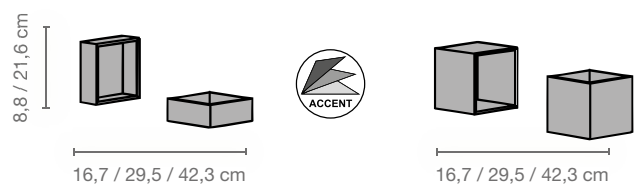
3 / 4 Raster high media lowboards
